CLASS OVERVIEW

Inspiration is everywhere—even in a convenience store in Poznań, Poland. In this fast-paced, hands-on session, Theresa shows how to pull colors from any photo or real-life moment and turn them into quilt-ready palettes using simple apps.

In less than 20 minutes, participants will create their own palette using an image from their camera roll—yes, even a random storefront or vacation snapshot—and see how those colors can inspire a quilt design through shades (darker tones) and tints (lighter tones).

The remaining time explores quick tips for using other ideas to guide fabric choices with confidence.
